10 WHEREAS, Robert attended Moraine Valley Community College
11 where he received his Associate of Science Degree in May 1988;
12 he went on to receive his Bachelor of Science Degree in Biology
13 Education from Western Illinois University in May 1991, his
14 Master of Science Degree in Biology from Western Illinois
15 University in December 1993, and his Graduate Certificate in
16 Community College Learning and Teaching from Loyola University
17 in 2006; he also completed coursework at the Problem-based
18 Learning Design Institute at Aurora University in July 2008;

21 Army Joliet Training Area, visiting lecturer at North Central

7 without professional recognition; while instructing at the
8 College of Lake County, Robert was awarded the Illinois
9 Community College Trustees Association Outstanding Full-time
10 Faculty Award in 2011, the College of Lake County Outstanding
11 Faculty Award in 2011, the National Association of Biology
12 Teachers Two-Year College Biology Teaching Award in 2010, and
13 the NISOD Teaching Excellence Award in 2005; and

14 WHEREAS, Robert has served as the past Chair of the
15 Two-Year Section of the National Association of Biology
16 Teachers and as the past President of the Illinois Association
17 of Community College Biologists, has co-authored a lab book for
18 Anatomy and Physiology, and is currently developing a new
19 course to teach science lab skills to students underprepared
20 for college science lab classes; therefore, be it
