WHEREAS, Another milestone has brought on a public clamor for a second resolution to reprise Charles Wheeler III's life's work and extend him best wishes on his 70th birthday; and

WHEREAS, Charles Wheeler III's life's work was highlighted by such feats as doing play-by-play of all 154 Milwaukee Braves games in 1954 for siblings and friends, using little more than a fertile imagination and an All-Star baseball spinner board; and

WHEREAS, Charles Wheeler III graduated from St. Mary's College and the Medill School of Journalism and labored for 3 years with the Peace Corps in Panama before stepping into the footprints left by 2 respected newspaper men, his father and grandfather; and
