1 HOUSE RESOLUTION 2 WHEREAS, Autism Spectrum Disorder can affect all 3 individuals regardless of racial, ethnic, economic, and social 4 groups; and 5 WHEREAS, Autism Spectrum Disorder is more common than pediatric cancer, diabetes, and AIDS combined; and 6 7 WHEREAS, It is diagnosed in 1 in 110 individuals in the 8 United States based on the 2007 CDC statistics; and 9 WHEREAS, The cause of Autism Spectrum Disorder is still 10 unknown but research strongly suggests that it is caused by certain factors that affect brain development; and 11 12 WHEREAS, Autism Spectrum Disorder has increased tenfold in 13 the last decade and now occurs in some form in 1 in 90 boys in 14 the United States; and 15 WHEREAS, Autism, which is four times more common in boys 16 than girls, usually appears during the first three years of 17 life; and 18 WHEREAS, Early diagnosis, research, training, education,

and therapies are vital to reducing the effects of Autism; and
