- 3 WHEREAS, Investing in clean energy can both create new jobs
- 4 in Illinois and make the United States more economically
- 5 competitive in the global economy; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The national and international challenges of
- 7 America's oil dependence are influenced by the energy policies
- 8 of individual states; and
- 9 WHEREAS, U.S. military veterans, including the veterans
- 10 coalition Operation Free, advocate for reducing America's oil
- 11 dependence in order to strengthen American security;
- 12 therefore, be it
- 13 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
- 14 NINETY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that
- 15 we state our intent to duly consider the ramifications for
- 16 America's security when taking up issues concerning energy
- development and our dependence on oil, adopt policies that
- 18 encourage the growth of the clean-energy sector in order to
- 19 encourage innovation, create jobs for Illinoisans, and
- strengthen America's security, and work with the clean energy
- 21 sector to develop clean energy job training and placement
- 22 programs for returning veterans; and be it further
