- 2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of 3 Representatives are deeply saddened to learn of the death of 4 Lombard Village President William "Bill" J. Mueller, who died 5 on August 18, 2012; and
- WHEREAS, Bill Mueller was raised in Lombard by his parents,

 Joseph and Dolorosa (nee Muldoon); he married Eileen Rogers;

- 9 WHEREAS, Bill Mueller served as village president since 10 1993, having begun his fifth consecutive term in May of 2009; 11 he was the longest serving village president in Lombard's 12 history; he was a veteran of the Illinois National Guard; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Bill Mueller began his political career in the 14 late 1950's as a member of the Village of Lombard's Safety Committee and the Lombard Youth Commission; he was District 15 16 Trustee from 1975 to 1979 and served as Chairman of the Public Works Committee as well as Chairman of the DuPage Community 17 18 Development Commission; he was president of the DuPage Mayors 19 and Managers Conference and Co-Chairman of the Glenbard Wastewater Authority; he was a member of the Lombard Chamber of 20 21 Commerce and Industry Eagle Club; he served on the boards and 22 committees of many local groups, such as the YMCA, St. Pius X

- 2 Lombard Chamber of Commerce; he was a former Lombard Man of the
- 3 Year; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Bill Mueller opened the Bill Mueller Insurance
- 5 Agency in 1965; he retired from American Family Insurance in
- 6 2005; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Bill Mueller was preceded in death by his nephew,
- 8 Joe Harrington; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Bill Mueller is survived by his wife, Eileen (nee
- 10 Rogers); his daughters, Debbie (Keith) Rapata, and Donna (Mark)
- 11 Fruehe; his grandchildren, K.J., Stephen, Mikey, and Ashley;
- 12 his brother, Thomas M. (Jane); his nieces and nephews, Mike
- 13 (Jenny) Mueller, Jim Mueller, Chris Williams, Cheryl (Jim)
