2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Pharmacy Practice Act is amended by changing
5 Section 7.5 as follows:

6 (225 ILCS 85/7.5)

7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2018)

8 Sec. 7.5. Social Security Number or unique identifying
9 number on license application. In addition to any ~~any~~ other
10 information required to be contained in the application, every
11 application for an original, renewal, or restored license under
12 this Act shall include the applicant's Social Security Number
13 or other unique identifying number deemed appropriate by the
14 Department.
