

97TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2011 and 2012 SB1724

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-696 new

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides for the issuance of Blue Star license plates to any Illinois resident whose spouse, parent, sibling, or child is serving in the United States Armed Forces. Provides that the plates shall be issued only to applicants who present appropriate documentation as determined by the Secretary. Provides that applicants shall be charged an additional \$15 for original issuance and additional \$2 at renewal, to be deposited into the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

AN ACT concerning transportation. 1

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 2 represented in the General Assembly: 3

- Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding 4 5 Section 3-696 as follows:
- (625 ILCS 5/3-696 new) 6
- 7 Sec. 3-696. Blue Star license plates.
- (a) The Secretary of State, upon receipt of an application 8 9 made in the form prescribed by the Secretary, may issue special 10 registration plates designated as Blue Star license plates to any Illinois resident whose spouse, parent, sibling, or child 11 is serving in the United States Armed Forces. Appropriate 12 documentation, as determined by the Secretary, and the 13 14 appropriate registration fee shall accompany the application. The special plates issued pursuant to this Section may be 15 affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division, 16 17 motorcycles, or motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates issued under this Section 18 19 shall expire according to the staggered multi-year procedure established by Section 3-414.1 of this Code.
 - (b) The design, color, and format of the plates shall be wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State. The Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to be

issued as vanity or personalized plates in accordance with

Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are not required to

designate "Land of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) of

Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary shall prescribe the

eligibility requirements and, in his or her discretion, shall

approve and prescribe stickers or decals as provided under

Section 3-412.

(c) An applicant shall be charged a \$15 fee for original issuance in addition to the applicable registration fee. This additional fee shall be deposited into the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund. For each registration renewal period, a \$2 fee, in addition to the applicable registration fee, shall be charged and shall be deposited into the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.
