1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 2169

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 2169, AS AMENDED,
3 with reference to page and line numbers of House Amendment No.
4 1 as follows:

5 on page 27, line 26, after "2.5%", by inserting "for each
6 corresponding year"; and

7 on page 31, line 6, after "provide", by inserting "certified";
8 and

9 on page 33, line 14, by replacing "for specific performance of"
10 with "to enforce"; and

11 on page 33, line 23, by deleting "for specific"; and

12 on page 33, line 24, by deleting "performance"; and

1 on page 43, lines 3 and 7, before "natural" each time it
2 appears, by inserting "baseload"; and

3 on page 43, line 18, immediately after "cost", by inserting
4 "l"; and

5 on page 43, by replacing lines 20 through 24 with "account.
6 Such credit payment shall be made monthly starting within 30
7 days after the completed analysis in this subsection (h-15) and
8 based on collections from all customers via a line item charge
9 in all customer bills designed to have an equal percentage
10 impact on the transportation services of each class of
11 customers. Credit payments made pursuant to this subparagraph
12 (A) shall be deemed prudent and reasonable and not subject to
13 Commission prudence review."; and

14 on page 44, by replacing line 7 with "(h-15), but only to the
15 extent that the reconciliation account has a positive
16 balance.".
