A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the
8 General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community College Board
9 for ordinary and contingent expenses:

10	For Personal Services	1,221,000
11	For State Contributions to Social	
12	Security, for Medicare	16,300
13	For Contractual Services	348,300
14	For Travel	45,000
15	For Commodities	6,400
16	For Printing	8,000
17	For Equipment	7,200
18	For Electronic Data Processing	454,900
19	For Telecommunications	30,900
20	For Operation of Automotive Equipment	<u>6,400</u>
21	Total	\$2,144,400

1 Section 10. The sum of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof as
 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Community
 3 College Board Contracts and Grants Fund to the Illinois
 4 Community College Board to be expended under the terms and
 5 conditions associated with the moneys being received.

6 Section 15. The sum of \$1,500,000, or so much thereof as
 7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the ICCB Adult
 8 Education Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for
 9 operational expenses associated with administration of adult
 10 education and literacy activities.

11 Section 20. The following named amounts, or so much
 12 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
 13 from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community
 14 College Board for distribution to qualifying public community
 15 colleges for the purposes specified:

17	Retirees Health Insurance Grants	626,600

20 Section 25. The following amounts, or so much thereof as
 21 may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated from the

1 Education Assistance Fund to the Illinois Community College
 2 Board for distribution to qualifying public community
 3 colleges for the purposes specified:

4	Base Operating Grants	\$198,811,000
5	Equalization Grants	<u>77,113,000</u>
6	Total	\$275,924,000

7 Section 26. The sum of \$1,589,100, or so much thereof as
 8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
 9 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for grants to
 10 operate an educational facility in the former community
 11 college district #541 in East St. Louis.

12 Section 35. The following named amounts, or so much of
 13 those amounts as may be necessary, for the objects and
 14 purposes named, are appropriated to the Illinois Community
 15 College Board for adult education and literacy activities:

16 From the General Revenue Fund:

17 For payment of costs associated
 18 with education and educational-related
 19 services to local eligible providers
 20 for adult education and

22 Section 40. The following named amounts, or so much
23 thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois
24 Community College Board for all costs associated with career

1 and technical education activities:

2 From the General Revenue Fund.....17,569,400

3 From the Career and Technical Education Fund.....23,607,100

4 Total, this Section \$41,176,500

5 Section 45. The sum of \$410,000, or so much thereof as

6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the ICCB Federal Trust

7 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for ordinary and

8 contingency expenses of the Board.

9 Section 50. The sum of \$15,000,000, or so much thereof

10 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue

11 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for the City

12 Colleges of Chicago for educational-related expenses.

13 Section 55. The sum of \$61,600, or so much thereof as

14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue

15 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for awarding

16 scholarships to qualifying graduates of the Lincoln's

17 Challenge Program.

18 Section 60. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as

19 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue

20 Fund to Illinois Community College Board for costs associated

21 with administering GED tests.

1 Section 65. The sum of \$750,000, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the ISBE GED Testing
3 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for costs
4 associated with administering GED tests.

5 Section 70. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from ICCB Instruction
7 Development and Enhancement Applications Revolving Fund to
8 the Illinois Community College Board for costs associated
9 with maintaining and updating instructional technology.

10 Section 75. The sum of \$7,261,500, or so much thereof as
11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
12 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board to reimburse
13 colleges up to 50 percent of the costs associated with the
14 Illinois Veterans' Grant.

15 Section 80. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as
16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
17 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for costs
18 associated with the College and Career Readiness Pilot
19 Program.

20 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
