1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much  
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects  
7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the  
8 Insurance Producer Administration Fund to the Department of  
9 Insurance:

8 shared services center.

10 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects  
11 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the  
12 Insurance Financial Regulation Fund to the Department of

9 Financial Regulation Fund to the Department of Insurance for  
10 costs and expenses related to or in support of a  
11 Regulatory/G&A shared services center.

12 Section 25. The following named amounts, or so much  
13 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects  
14 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the  
15 Public Pension Regulation Fund to the Department of  
16 Insurance:

7 Section 30. The sum of \$2,685,500, or so much thereof as  
8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Senior Health  
9 Insurance Program Fund to the Department of Insurance for the  
10 administration of the Senior Health Insurance Program.

11 Section 35. The sum of \$485,000, or so much thereof as  
12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Workers'  
13 Compensation Commission Operations Fund to the Department of  
14 Insurance for costs associated with the administration and  
15 operations of the Insurance Fraud Division of the Illinois  
16 Workers' Compensation Commission's anti-fraud program.

17 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
18 2011.
