1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 2458

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 2458, AS AMENDED,
3 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the
4 following:

5 "Section 5. The amount of \$10,806,400, or so much thereof
6 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Personal
7 Property Tax Replacement Fund to the Illinois State Board of
8 Education for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2011 for
9 Regional Superintendents' and Assistants' Compensation and
10 Related Benefits.

11 Section 10. The following named amounts, or so much
12 thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois
13 State Board of Education for the fiscal year beginning July
14 1, 2011:

1 From the Personal Property Tax Replacement Fund:
 2 For Regional Superintendents' Services\$2,225,050

3 Section 15. The following amounts, or so much of those
 4 amounts as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
 5 to the State Board of Elections for its ordinary and
 6 contingent expenses from the Personal Property Tax
 7 Replacement Fund as follows:

8 For Payment of Lump Sum Awards to County Clerks,
 9 County Recorders, and Chief Election
 10 Clerks as Compensation for Additional
 11 Duties required of such officials
 12 by consolidation of elections law,
 13 as provided in Public Acts 82-691
 14 and 90-713 806,000

15 Section 20. "An Act making appropriations", Public Act 97-
 16 56 is amended by changing Section 10 of Article 5 as follows:
