

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much of
6 those amounts as may be necessary, respectively, for the
7 objects and purposes named in this Section, are appropriated
8 to the State Treasurer for the payment of interest on and
9 retirement of State bonded indebtedness:

10 For payment of principal and interest on any and all bonds
11 issued pursuant to the Anti-Pollution Bond Act, the
12 Transportation Bond Act, the Capital Development Bond Act of
13 1972, the School Construction Bond Act, the Illinois Coal and
14 Energy Development Bond Act, and the General Obligation Bond
15 Act:

16 From the General Obligation Bond

17 Retirement and Interest Fund:

21 ARTICLE 2

1 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
 2 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
 3 and purposes hereinafter named are appropriated to the
 4 Department of Central Management Services:

6 PAYABLE FROM GENERAL REVENUE FUND

7 For Group Insurance550,000,000

8 PAYABLE FROM ROAD FUND

1 Section 5. In addition to any amounts heretofore
 2 appropriated, the following named amounts, or so much thereof
 3 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the
 4 Department of Healthcare and Family Services for Medical
 5 Assistance:

6 FOR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE UNDER THE ILLINOIS PUBLIC AID CODE,
 7 THE CHILDREN'S HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM ACT,
 8 THE COVERING ALL KIDS HEALTH INSURANCE ACT, AND
 9 THE SENIOR CITIZENS AND DISABLED PERSONS PROPERTY TAX RELIEF
 10 AND PHARMACEUTICAL ASSISTANCE ACT

11 Payable from General Revenue Fund:

12 For Medical Assistance Providers
 13 and Related Operating and
 14 Administrative Costs6,638,953,200

15 The Department, with the consent in writing from the
 16 Governor, may reapportion not more than four percent of the
 17 total General Revenue Fund appropriations in Section 5 above
 18 among the various purposes therein enumerated.

19 ARTICLE 4

20 Section 1. The sum of \$1,242,800,000, or so much thereof
 21 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education

1 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the State
2 Universities Retirement System for the State's contribution,
3 as provided by law.

4 Section 5. The sum of \$160,000,000, or so much thereof as
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Pensions
6 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the State Universities
7 Retirement System pursuant to the provisions of Section 8.12
8 of the State Finance Act.

9 ARTICLE 5

10 Section 1. The sum of \$1,041,371,800, or so much thereof
11 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
12 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the State Employees'
13 Retirement System of Illinois for the State's contribution,
14 as provided by law.

15 Section 5. The sum of \$88,210,000, or so much thereof as
16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
17 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the Judges' Retirement
18 System of Illinois for the State's contribution, as provided
19 by law.

20 Section 10. The sum of \$14,150,000, or so much thereof

1 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
2 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the General Assembly
3 Retirement System for the State's contribution, as provided
4 by law.

5 ARTICLE 6

6 Section 1. The sum of \$2,702,278,000, or so much thereof
7 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Common School
8 Fund to the Teachers' Retirement System of the State of
9 Illinois for the State's contribution, as provided by law.

10 Section 5. The sum of \$1,200,000, or so much thereof as
11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
12 Assistance Fund to the Teachers' Retirement System of the
13 State of Illinois for additional costs due to the
14 establishment of minimum retirement allowances pursuant to
15 Sections 16-136.2 and 16-136.3 of the Illinois Pension Code,
16 as amended.

17 Section 10. The amount of \$10,931,000, or so much thereof
18 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
19 Fund to the Public School Teachers' Pension and Retirement
20 Fund of Chicago for the State's contribution for retirement
21 contributions under Section 17-127 of the Illinois Pension

1 Code for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2012.

2 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
3 2012.
