1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 2461

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 2461, AS AMENDED, by  
3 deleting everything after the enacting clause and replacing it  
4 with the following:

5 "ARTICLE 1

6 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much of  
7 those amounts as may be necessary, respectively, for the  
8 objects and purposes named in this Section, are appropriated  
9 to the State Treasurer for the payment of interest on and  
10 retirement of State bonded indebtedness:

11 For payment of principal and interest on any and all bonds  
12 issued pursuant to the Anti-Pollution Bond Act, the  
13 Transportation Bond Act, the Capital Development Bond Act of  
14 1972, the School Construction Bond Act, the Illinois Coal and

1	Energy Development Bond Act, and the General Obligation Bond	
2	Act:

8 ARTICLE 2

9 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much  
10 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects  
11 and purposes hereinafter named are appropriated to the  
12 Department of Central Management Services:

8 ARTICLE 3

9 Section 5. In addition to any amounts heretofore  
10 appropriated, the following named amounts, or so much thereof  
11 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the  
12 Department of Healthcare and Family Services for Medical  
13 Assistance:

- 14 FOR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE UNDER THE ILLINOIS PUBLIC AID CODE,
- 15 THE CHILDREN'S HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM ACT,
- 16 THE COVERING ALL KIDS HEALTH INSURANCE ACT, AND
- 17 THE SENIOR CITIZENS AND DISABLED PERSONS PROPERTY TAX RELIEF
- 18 AND PHARMACEUTICAL ASSISTANCE ACT

19 Payable from General Revenue Fund:

20 For Medical Assistance Providers

21 and Related Operating and

22 Administrative Costs .....6,638,953,200

1           The Department, with the consent in writing from the  
2           Governor, may reappropriation not more than four percent of the  
3           total General Revenue Fund appropriations in Section 5 above  
4           among the various purposes therein enumerated.

5   ARTICLE 4

6           Section 1. The sum of \$1,242,800,000, or so much thereof  
7           as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education  
8           Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the State  
9           Universities Retirement System for the State's contribution,  
10          as provided by law.

11          Section 5. The sum of \$160,000,000, or so much thereof as  
12          may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Pensions  
13          Fund to the Board of Trustees of the State Universities  
14          Retirement System pursuant to the provisions of Section 8.12  
15          of the State Finance Act.

16   ARTICLE 5

17          Section 1. The sum of \$1,041,371,800, or so much thereof  
18          as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
19          Fund to the Board of Trustees of the State Employees'  
20          Retirement System of Illinois for the State's contribution,

1 as provided by law.

2 Section 5. The sum of \$88,210,000, or so much thereof as  
3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
4 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the Judges' Retirement  
5 System of Illinois for the State's contribution, as provided  
6 by law.

7 Section 10. The sum of \$14,150,000, or so much thereof  
8 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
9 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the General Assembly  
10 Retirement System for the State's contribution, as provided  
11 by law.

12 ARTICLE 6

13 Section 1. The sum of \$2,702,278,000, or so much thereof  
14 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Common School  
15 Fund to the Teachers' Retirement System of the State of  
16 Illinois for the State's contribution, as provided by law.

17 Section 5. The sum of \$1,200,000, or so much thereof as  
18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education  
19 Assistance Fund to the Teachers' Retirement System of the  
20 State of Illinois for additional costs due to the

1 establishment of minimum retirement allowances pursuant to  
2 Sections 16-136.2 and 16-136.3 of the Illinois Pension Code,  
3 as amended.

4 Section 10. The amount of \$10,931,000, or so much thereof  
5 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
6 Fund to the Public School Teachers' Pension and Retirement  
7 Fund of Chicago for the state's contribution for retirement  
8 contributions under Section 17-127 of the Illinois Pension  
9 Code for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2012.

10 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July  
11 1, 2012."
