

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1. The following named amounts, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated

24 Controlled Substances Act, and the Environmental Safety Act.

1 Section 10. The sum of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof as
 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Asset
 3 Forfeiture Fund to the Department of State Police for payment
 4 of their expenditures in accordance with the Federal
 5 Equitable Sharing Guidelines.

6 Section 15. The sum of \$1,500,000, or so much thereof as
 7 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of State
 8 Police, Division of Administration, from the Money Laundering
 9 Asset Recovery Fund for the ordinary and contingent expenses
 10 incurred by the Department of State Police.

11 Section 20. The following named amounts, or so much

12 Section 35. The following amounts, or so much thereof as
 13 may be necessary for objects and purposes hereinafter named,
 14 are appropriated from the Drug Traffic Prevention Fund to the
 15 Department of State Police, Division of Operations, pursuant
 16 to the provisions of the "Intergovernmental Drug Laws
 17 Enforcement Act" for Grants to Metropolitan Enforcement
 18 Groups.

19 For Grants to Metropolitan Enforcement Groups:
 20 Payable from the Drug Traffic
 21 Prevention Fund500,000

22 Section 40. In the event of the receipt of funds from

1 the Motor Vehicle Theft Prevention Council, through a grant
2 from the Criminal Justice Information Authority, the amount
3 of \$600,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is
4 appropriated from the State Police Motor Vehicle Theft
5 Prevention Trust Fund to the Department of State Police for
6 payment of expenses.

7 Section 45. The sum of \$8,250,000, or so much thereof as
8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Police
9 Whistleblower Reward and Protection Fund to the Department of
10 State Police for payment of their expenditures for state law
11 enforcement purposes in accordance with the State
12 Whistleblower Protection Act.

13 Section 50. The sum of \$22,000,000, or so much thereof
14 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Police
15 Operations Assistance Fund to the Department of State Police
16 for the ordinary and contingent expenses incurred by the
17 Department of State Police.

18 Section 55. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as
19 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Police
20 Streetgang-Related Crime Fund to the Department of State
21 Police for operations related to streetgang-related Crime
22 Initiatives.

1 Section 60. The sum of \$125,000, or so much thereof as
 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Over Dimensional
 3 Load Police Escort Fund to the Department of State Police for
 4 expenses incurred for providing police escorts for over-
 5 dimensional loads.

6 Section 65. The following amounts, or so much thereof as
 7 may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated from the
 8 General Revenue Fund to the Department of State Police for
 9 the expenses of Fraud Investigations:
