- 4 Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by changing
- 5 Section 3-1 as follows:
- 6 (720 ILCS 5/3-1) (from Ch. 38, par. 3-1)
- 7 Sec. 3-1. Presumption of innocence <u>and</u> and proof of guilt.
- 8 Every person is presumed innocent until proved guilty. No
- 9 person shall be convicted of any offense unless his guilt
- 10 thereof is proved beyond a reasonable doubt.
