1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 3047

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 3047 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Illinois Highway Code is amended by
5 changing Section 6-104 as follows:

6 (605 ILCS 5/6-104) (from Ch. 121, par. 6-104)

7 Sec. 6-104. Whenever the territory of any municipality ~~of a~~
8 ~~population of not less than 15,000~~ is a part of a road district
9 ~~two or more road districts~~ in a county not under township
10 organization, and shall by resolution of its council or its
11 president and board of trustees request the county board to
12 organize it into a separate road district and designate the
13 name thereof, the county board shall comply with such request,
14 and provide for such organization of such municipality into a
15 new road district under the name designated in such resolution
16 of such city council, or president and board of trustees, if

1 any be designated therein.

2 Whenever a road district shall have been or shall hereafter
3 be organized as provided in this Section and any of the
4 territory of such municipality shall be disconnected from such
5 municipality, the county board, upon receipt of a certified
6 copy of the resolution or ordinance of the municipality
7 disconnecting such territory, by resolution, shall disconnect
8 such territory from such road district and annex it to an
9 adjacent road district or districts. Whenever such
10 municipality, at any one time shall have annexed or shall
11 hereafter annex any territory, the county board, by resolution,
12 shall disconnect such territory from the road district or
13 districts in which it may be situated and annex the same to the
14 road district in which such municipality is situated.

15 All the powers vested in a road district organized out of
16 the territory embraced within any municipality, including all
17 the powers vested by law in the highway commissioner of a road
18 district, shall be vested in and exercised by the city council,
19 or president and board of trustees of such municipality,
20 including the power to levy a tax for the proper construction,
21 maintenance and repair of roads in such district as provided in
22 Section 6--501 of this Code. Any such tax whether heretofore or
23 hereafter levied shall be in addition to all other taxes levied
24 in such municipality and in addition to the taxes for general
25 purposes authorized in Section 8-3-1 of the Illinois Municipal
26 Code, as heretofore and hereafter amended.

1 All of the powers vested by law in the district clerk of a
2 road district shall be vested in and exercised by the city,
3 town or village clerk of such municipality.

4 After a road district has been organized out of the
5 territory embraced within a municipality, the offices and
6 election of highway commissioner and district clerk shall be
7 discontinued.

9 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
10 becoming law.".
