Amends the School Code. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning trustees of schools.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning education.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section
5 5-21 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/5-21) (from Ch. 122, par. 5-21)

7 Sec. 5-21. Gifts, grants, donations, legacies - Title to
8 property. The ~~The~~ trustees of schools in townships in which
9 that office has not been abolished as provided in subsection
10 (c) of Section 5-1 may receive any gift, grant, donation or
11 legacy made for the use of any school or library or for any
12 other school purpose within their jurisdiction. They are
13 invested in their corporate capacity with the title of all
14 school buildings and school sites, except as otherwise provided
15 by clause (3) of subsection (b) of Section 5-1 with respect to
16 school districts which have withdrawn from the jurisdiction and
17 authority of the trustees of school. All conveyances of real
18 estate made to the trustees of schools shall be made to them in
19 their corporate name and to their successors in office. School
20 districts may take and convey title to real estate to be
21 improved by buildings or other structures for vocational or
22 other educational training of pupils as provided in Section
23 10-23.3. If legal title to the real estate to be so improved

1 for vocational or other educational training of pupils as
2 provided in Section 10-23.3 is not held by the school board of
3 the school district, the trustees of schools or other school
4 officials having legal title to those school sites or other
5 school property shall convey to the school district the title
6 to any such school site or other school property or portion
7 thereof held for such district, to be used as provided in
8 Section 10-23.3, upon being presented with a resolution adopted
9 by at least 2/3 of the members of such board requesting such
10 conveyance.

11 If the trustees of schools for a township are no longer in
12 existence, the school district shall take and convey title to
13 all school buildings and school sites to be acquired within
14 such township. If the trustees of schools had previously taken
15 title to a school building or a school site and such trustees
16 are no longer in existence, the school district shall by
17 operation of law automatically be vested with title to all
18 school buildings and school sites within such township and
19 shall have authority to convey title thereto.
