SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Defines "former military vehicle" as a vehicle or trailer, regardless of size, weight, or year of manufacture, that was manufactured for use in any country's military forces and is maintained to depict or represent military design or markings, and does not include a vehicle used for any commercial or production agriculture purpose. Provides that the owner of a former military vehicle may register the vehicle for a fee not to exceed \$100 for a vehicle with a gross vehicle weight rating of 26,000 pounds or less; \$150 for a vehicle with a gross vehicle weight rating of over 26,000 pounds; \$25 for a trailer with a weight of 3,000 pounds or less; or \$75 for a trailer with a weight of over 3,000 pounds. Provides that the Secretary of State may prescribe that former military vehicle plates be issued for a definite or an indefinite term, such term to correspond to the term of registration plates issued generally as provided by law. Provides that any person requesting former military vehicle plates may also apply to have vanity or personalized plates. Provides that a vehicle registered as a former military vehicle is not subject to weight tax requirements. Effective immediately.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
5 Sections 3-806 and 3-815 and by adding Sections 1-123.2 and
6 3-804.3 as follows:

7 (625 ILCS 5/1-123.2 new)

8 Sec. 1-123.2. Former military vehicle. A vehicle or
9 trailer, regardless of size, weight, or year of manufacture,
10 that was manufactured for use in any country's military forces
11 and is maintained to depict or represent military design or
12 markings. A former military vehicle does not include a vehicle
13 used for any commercial or production agriculture purpose.

15 Sec. 3-804.3. Former military vehicles.

16 (a) The owner of a former military vehicle may register the
17 vehicle for a fee not to exceed:

18 (1) \$100 for a vehicle with a gross vehicle weight
19 rating of 26,000 pounds or less;

20 (2) \$150 for a vehicle with a gross vehicle weight
21 rating of over 26,000 pounds;

22 (3) \$25 for a trailer with a weight of 3,000 pounds or

9 Beginning with the 2010 registration year a \$1 surcharge

21 division.

22 (a) Except as provided in Section 3-806.3 and 3-804.3,
23 every owner of a vehicle of the second division registered
24 under Section 3-813, and not registered under the mileage
25 weight tax under Section 3-818, shall pay to the Secretary of

1 State, for each registration year, for the use of the public
 2 highways, a flat weight tax at the rates set forth in the
 3 following table, the rates including the \$10 registration fee:

26 Beginning with the 2010 registration year a \$1 surcharge

1 shall be collected for vehicles registered in the 8,000 lbs.
2 and less flat weight plate category above to be deposited into
3 the State Police Vehicle Fund.

4 All of the proceeds of the additional fees imposed by this
5 amendatory Act of the 96th General Assembly shall be deposited
6 into the Capital Projects Fund.

7 (a-1) A Special Hauling Vehicle is a vehicle or combination
8 of vehicles of the second division registered under Section
9 3-813 transporting asphalt or concrete in the plastic state or
10 a vehicle or combination of vehicles that are subject to the
11 gross weight limitations in subsection (a) of Section 15-111
12 for which the owner of the vehicle or combination of vehicles
13 has elected to pay, in addition to the registration fee in
14 subsection (a), \$125 to the Secretary of State for each
15 registration year. The Secretary shall designate this class of
16 vehicle as a Special Hauling Vehicle.

17 (b) Except as provided in Section 3-806.3, every camping
18 trailer, motor home, mini motor home, travel trailer, truck
19 camper or van camper used primarily for recreational purposes,
20 and not used commercially, nor for hire, nor owned by a
21 commercial business, may be registered for each registration
22 year upon the filing of a proper application and the payment of
23 a registration fee and highway use tax, according to the
24 following table of fees:

Every house trailer must be registered under Section 3-819.

(c) Farm Truck. Any truck used exclusively for the owner's own agricultural, horticultural or livestock raising operations and not-for-hire only, or any truck used only in the transportation for-hire of seasonal, fresh, perishable fruit or vegetables from farm to the point of first processing, may be registered by the owner under this paragraph in lieu of registration under paragraph (a), upon filing of a proper application and the payment of the \$10 registration fee and the highway use tax herein specified as follows:

14 In the event the Secretary of State revokes a farm truck
15 registration as authorized by law, the owner shall pay the flat
16 weight tax due hereunder before operating such truck.

17 Any combination of vehicles having 5 axles, with a distance
18 of 42 feet or less between extreme axles, that are subject to
19 the weight limitations in subsection (a) of Section 15-111 for
20 which the owner of the combination of vehicles has elected to
21 pay, in addition to the registration fee in subsection (c),
22 \$125 to the Secretary of State for each registration year shall
23 be designated by the Secretary as a Special Hauling Vehicle.

24 (d) The number of axles necessary to carry the maximum load
25 provided shall be determined from Chapter 15 of this Code.

26 (e) An owner may only apply for and receive 5 farm truck

1 registrations, and only 2 of those 5 vehicles shall exceed
2 59,500 gross weight in pounds per vehicle.

3 (f) Every person convicted of violating this Section by
4 failure to pay the appropriate flat weight tax to the Secretary
5 of State as set forth in the above tables shall be punished as
6 provided for in Section 3-401.
