1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 3571

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 3571 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Early Intervention Services System Act is
5 amended by changing Section 13.50 as follows:

6 (325 ILCS 20/13.50)

7 Sec. 13.50. Early Intervention Legislative Advisory
8 Committee. No later than 60 days after the effective date of
9 this amendatory Act of the 97th General Assembly August 9, 2001
10 ~~(the effective date of Public Act 92-307)~~, there shall be
11 convened the Early Intervention Legislative Advisory
12 Committee. The majority and minority leaders of the General
13 Assembly shall each appoint 2 members to the Committee. The
14 Legislative Advisory Committee shall be dissolved, and the
15 terms of its members shall expire, on September 1, 2016. The
16 Committee ~~Committee's term is for a period of 4 years, and the~~

1 ~~Committee~~ shall publicly convene no less than 2 ~~4~~ times per
2 year. The Committee's responsibilities shall include, but not
3 be limited to, providing guidance to the lead agency regarding
4 programmatic and fiscal management and accountability,
5 provider development and accountability, contracting, systems'
6 coordination, and program outcome measures. During the life of
7 the Committee, on a quarterly basis, or more often as the
8 Committee may request, the lead agency shall provide to the
9 Committee, and simultaneously to the public, through postings
10 on the lead agency's early intervention website, quarterly
11 reports containing monthly data and other early intervention
12 program information that the Committee requests. The first data
13 report must be supplied no later than October 31, 2012
14 ~~September 21, 2001,~~ and must include the previous 2 quarters of
15 data. The Ounce of Prevention Fund shall provide staff and
16 administrative support services to the Committee.
