#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

15 ILCS 50/17 new  
20 ILCS 5/5-20

was 20 ILCS 5/4

Amends the Gubernatorial Boards and Commissions Act. Provides that a person is ineligible for appointment or reappointment to any board or commission for a term of office beginning on or after the effective date of the amendatory Act, if the person is a spouse, child, or spouse of a child of a State official. Amends the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois. Provides that a person is ineligible for appointment or reappointment as the head officer of a department of State government for a term of office beginning on or after the effective date of the amendatory Act, if the person is a spouse, child, or spouse of a child of a State official. Defines "official".

1 AN ACT concerning State government.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Gubernatorial Boards and Commissions Act is  
5 amended by adding Section 17 as follows:

6 (15 ILCS 50/17 new)

7 Sec. 17. Eligibility for appointment or reappointment to a  
8 board or commission. A person is ineligible for appointment or  
9 reappointment to any board or commission for a term of office  
10 beginning on or after the effective date of this amendatory Act  
11 of the 97th General Assembly, if the person is a spouse, child,  
12 or spouse of a child of a State official, as that term is  
13 defined in subsection (c) of Section 2 of the Lobbyist  
14 Registration Act.

15 Section 10. The Civil Administrative Code of Illinois is  
16 amended by changing Section 5-20 as follows:

17 (20 ILCS 5/5-20) (was 20 ILCS 5/4)

18 Sec. 5-20. Heads of departments.

19 (a) Each department shall have an officer as its head who  
20 shall be known as director or secretary and who shall, subject  
21 to the provisions of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois,

1 execute the powers and discharge the duties vested by law in  
2 his or her respective department.

3 The following officers are hereby created:

4 Director of Aging, for the Department on Aging.

5 Director of Agriculture, for the Department of  
6 Agriculture.

7 Director of Central Management Services, for the  
8 Department of Central Management Services.

9 Director of Children and Family Services, for the  
10 Department of Children and Family Services.

11 Director of Commerce and Economic Opportunity, for the  
12 Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity.

13 Director of Corrections, for the Department of  
14 Corrections.

15 Director of the Illinois Emergency Management Agency, for  
16 the Illinois Emergency Management Agency.

17 Director of Employment Security, for the Department of  
18 Employment Security.

19 Secretary of Financial and Professional Regulation, for  
20 the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation.

21 Director of Healthcare and Family Services, for the  
22 Department of Healthcare and Family Services.

23 Director of Human Rights, for the Department of Human  
24 Rights.

25 Secretary of Human Services, for the Department of Human  
26 Services.

1 Director of Juvenile Justice, for the Department of  
2 Juvenile Justice.

3 Director of Labor, for the Department of Labor.

4 Director of Natural Resources, for the Department of  
5 Natural Resources.

6 Director of Public Health, for the Department of Public  
7 Health.

8 Director of Revenue, for the Department of Revenue.

9 Director of State Police, for the Department of State  
10 Police.

11 Secretary of Transportation, for the Department of  
12 Transportation.

13 Director of Veterans' Affairs, for the Department of  
14 Veterans' Affairs.

15 (b) A person is ineligible for appointment or reappointment  
16 as the head officer of a department for a term of office  
17 beginning on or after the effective date of this amendatory Act  
18 of the 97th General Assembly, if the person is a spouse, child,  
19 or spouse of a child of a State official, as that term is  
20 defined in subsection (c) of Section 2 of the Lobbyist  
21 Registration Act.
