A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1. The following named amounts, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
7 to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission from the
8 Student Loan Operating Fund for its ordinary and contingent
9 expenses:

5 Section 5. The sum of \$436,680,000, or so much thereof
6 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
7 Assistance Commission from the General Revenue Fund for
8 payment of Monetary Award Program grant awards to students
9 eligible to receive such awards, as provided by law.

10 Section 10. The sum of \$6,000,000, or so much thereof as
11 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
12 Assistance Commission from the Education Assistance Fund for
13 payment of military veterans' scholarships at state-
14 controlled universities and at public community colleges for
15 students eligible, as provided by law.

16 Section 15. The following named amounts, or so much
17 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
18 from the Education Assistance Fund to the Illinois Student
19 Assistance Commission for the following purposes:

20 Grants and Scholarships
21 For payment of matching grants to Illinois
22 institutions to supplement scholarship

1	programs, as provided by law	365,000
2	For the payment of scholarships to students	
3	who are children of policemen or firemen	
4	killed in the line of duty, or who are	
5	dependents of correctional officers killed	
6	or permanently disabled in the line of	
7	duty, as provided by law	1,050,000
8	For payment of Illinois National Guard and	
9	Naval Militia Scholarships at

17 Section 20. The following named amount, or so much
 18 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
 19 Illinois National Guard and Naval Militia Grant Fund to the
 20 Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the following
 21 purpose:

22 Grants and Scholarships
 23 For payment of Illinois National Guard and
 24 Naval Militia Scholarships

1 at State-controlled universities
2 and public community colleges in
3 Illinois to students eligible to
4 receive such awards, as provided by law20,000

5 Section 25. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
7 Assistance Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission
8 for the Loan Repayment for Teachers Program.

9 Section 30. The sum of \$30,000, or so much thereof as
10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
11 Assistance Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission
12 for costs associated with the Veterans' Home Nurses' Loan
13 Repayment Program pursuant to Public Act 95-0576.

14 Section 35. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as
15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
16 Assistance Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission
17 for grants to eligible nurse educators to use for payment of
18 their educational loan pursuant to Public Act 94-1020.

19 Section 40. The following named amount, or so much
20 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
21 Education Assistance Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance

1 Commission for the following purpose:

2 Grants and Scholarships

3 For payment of Illinois Future Teacher

4 Corps Scholarships, as provided by law2,000,000

5 Section 45. The following named amount, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
7 Contracts and Grants Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance
8 Commission for the following purpose:

9 To support outreach, research, and

10 training activities25,000,000

11 Section 50. The following named amount, or so much
12 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
13 Optometric Licensing and Disciplinary Board Fund to the
14 Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the following
15 purpose:

16 Grants and Scholarships

17 For payment of scholarships for the

18 Optometric Education Scholarship

19 Program, as provided by law50,000

20 Section 55. The sum of \$290,000,000, or so much thereof
21 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Student
22 Loan Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for

1 distribution when necessary as a result of the following: for
2 guarantees of loans that are uncollectible, for collection
3 payments to the Student Loan Operating Fund as required under
4 agreements with the United States Secretary of Education, for
5 payment to the Student Loan Operating Fund for Default
6 Aversion Fees, for transfers to the U.S. Treasury, or for
7 other distributions as necessary and provided for under the
8 Federal Higher Education Act.

9 Section 60. The sum of \$15,000,000, or so much thereof
10 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
11 Assistance Commission from the Student Loan Operating Fund
12 for distribution as necessary for the following: for payment
13 of collection agency fees associated with collection
14 activities for Federal Family Education Loans, for Default
15 Aversion Fee reversals, and for distributions as necessary
16 and provided for under the Federal Higher Education Act.

17 Section 65. The sum of \$3,500,000, or so much thereof as
18 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
19 Assistance Commission from the Student Loan Operating Fund
20 for costs associated with Federal Loan System Development and
21 Maintenance.

22 Section 70. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Accounts
 2 Receivable Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission
 3 for costs associated with the collection of delinquent
 4 scholarship awards pursuant to the Illinois State Collection
 5 Act of 1986.

6 Section 75. The sum of \$90,000, or so much thereof as
 7 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
 8 Assistance Commission from the University Grant Fund for
 9 payment of grants for the Higher Education License Plate
 10 Program, as provided by law.

11 Section 80. The following named amount, or so much
 12 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal
 13 Congressional Teacher Scholarship Program Fund to the
 14 Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the following
 15 purpose:

16 For transferring repayment funds collected
 17 under the Paul Douglas Teacher Scholarship
 18 Program to the U.S. Treasury400,000

19 Section 85. The following named amount, or so much
 20 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
 21 Illinois Future Teacher Corps Scholarship Fund to the
 22 Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the following

1 purpose:

2 For payment of scholarships for the
 3 Illinois Future Teacher Corps
 4 Scholarship Program as provided by law57,000
 5 For payment for grants to the Golden Apple
 6 Foundation for Excellence in Teaching3,000

7 Section 90. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
 8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Student
 9 Incentive Trust Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance
 10 Commission for the John R. Justice Student Loan Repayment
 11 Program.

12 Section 95. The sum of \$15,000,000, or so much thereof
 13 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Student
 14 Incentive Trust Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance
 15 Commission for payment of grants for the Federal College
 16 Access Challenge Grant Program, with up to six percent of the
 17 funding appropriated to meet allowable administrative costs,
 18 as part of the College Cost Reduction and Access Act (CCRAA),
 19 as provided by law.

20 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
 21 2012.
