9 Waukegan public schools, and after retirement taught part-time  
10 at AAUW Nursery School; during her career she also taught in  
11 Belvidere and Park Ridge; and

WHEREAS, Norma Kendrick was a lover of music; she  
13 co-founded the Sweet Adelines chapter in Waukegan in the 1950s;  
14 she was a Sunday school teacher at First Christian Church of  
15 Waukegan for more than 2 decades and participated in the  
16 church's clown ministry; she was a member of the Waukegan  
17 Newcomers Club; and
