The Small Business Contracts Act is amended by 4 changing Sections 5 and 10 and by adding Sections 12 and 25 as 5 6 follows: 7 (30 ILCS 503/5) Sec. 5. Definitions. For the purposes of this Act, the 8 following terms shall have the following definitions: 9 "Small business" means a small business as defined in the 10 Illinois Procurement Code. 11 "State contract" means a State contract, as defined in the 12 13 Illinois Procurement Code, funded with State or federal funds, whether competitively bid or negotiated. 14

"State official or agency" means a department, officer,

board, commission, institution, or body politic or corporate of

- 2 "Subcontract" means a subcontract, as defined in the
- 3 Illinois Procurement Code, funded with State or federal funds,
- 4 whether competitively bid or not.

- 7 Sec. 10. Award of State contracts.
- 8 (a) Not less than 10% of the total dollar amount of State
- 9 contracts shall be established as a goal to be awarded \underline{as} \underline{a}
- 10 contract or subcontract to small businesses.
- 11 (b) The percentage in subsection (a) relates to the total
- dollar amount of State contracts during each State fiscal year,
- calculated by examining independently each type of contract for
- 14 each State official or agency which lets such contracts.

- 17 Sec. 12. Small business presentations. During each fiscal
- 18 year, the chief procurement officers, individually or as a
- 19 group, shall provide presentations at which small businesses
- 20 may learn about the contracting process and how to apply for
- 21 contracts.

- Sec. 25. Rulemaking. Subject to rulemaking provisions in

- 1 the Illinois Administrative Procedure Act, each chief
- 2 procurement officer may adopt rules to implement and administer
- 3 this Act.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 4
- 5 becoming law.".
