1 AN ACT concerning public health.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Wholesale Drug Distribution Licensing Act is amended by adding Section 200 as follows:
- 6 (225 ILCS 120/200 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 200. Drugs in shortage.</u>
- 8 (a) For the purpose of this Section, "drug in shortage"
 9 means a drug listed on the drug shortage list maintained by the
 10 U.S. Food and Drug Administration in accordance with Section
- 11 356e of the federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act.
- 12 <u>(b) Any person engaged in the wholesale distribution of a</u>
 13 <u>drug in shortage must be licensed by the Department. This</u>
 14 <u>subsection (b) shall not apply to entities within the normal</u>
- distribution channel as defined under Section 15 of this Act.
- 16 <u>(c) It is unlawful for any person, other than those</u>
 17 licensed as a manufacturer, a manufacturer's exclusive
- 18 <u>distributor</u>, or an authorized distributor of record, to
- 19 purchase or receive a drug in shortage from any person not
- 20 <u>licensed by the Department. This subsection (c) does not apply</u>
- 21 <u>to the return of drugs.</u>
- 22 (d) A person found to have violated a provision of this
- 23 <u>Section shall be subject to administrative fines, orders for</u>

- restitution, and orders for disgorgement. 1
- 2 (e) The Department shall create a centralized, searchable
- 3 database of those entities licensed to sell or distribute a
- 4 drug in shortage, including manufacturers, wholesale
- distributors, and pharmacy distributors, to enable purchasers 5
- 6 of a drug in shortage to easily verify the licensing status of
- 7 an entity offering such drugs.
- (f) The Department shall establish a system for reporting 8
- 9 the suspected instances of unscrupulous conduct by
- distributors of a drug in shortage. Reports made through this 10
- 11 system shall be referred to the Office of the Attorney General
- 12 for further investigation and prosecution.
- 13 (g) The Department shall adopt rules to carry out the
- 14 provisions of this Section.
- 15 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 16 becoming law.
