# Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly: 

Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Sections 10-20.55 and 34-18.48 as follows:

boards shall designate the first Monday in October of each year
"Bring Your Parents to School Day" to promote parental
involvement and student success. On this day, a school board
