3	everything after the enacting clause with the following:
4 5	"Section 5. The Election Code is amended by adding Section 3-6 as follows:
6	(10 ILCS 5/3-6 new)
7	Sec. 3-6. Voting age. Notwithstanding any other provision
8	of law, a person who is 17 years old on the date of a primary
9	election and who is otherwise qualified to vote is qualified to
10	vote at that primary, including voting an absentee, grace
11	period, or early voting ballot with respect to that primary, if
12	that person will be 18 years old on the date of the immediately
13	following general election or consolidated election.
14	References in this Code and elsewhere to the requirement
15	that a person must be 18 years old to vote shall be interpreted
16	in accordance with this Section.
