

1 AN ACT concerning education.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Section
5 22-77 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/22-77 new)

7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on July 1, 2014)

8 Sec. 22-77. Young Adults Heroin Use Task Force.

9 (a) There is created the Young Adults Heroin Use Task Force
10 to address the growing problem of heroin use in high schools
11 across this State. The Task Force shall consist of all of the
12 following members:

13 (1) Four members of the House of Representatives,
14 appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

15 (2) Three members of the House of Representatives,
16 appointed by the Minority Leader of the House of
17 Representatives.

18 Members of the Task Force shall serve without compensation
19 but shall be reimbursed for their reasonable and necessary
20 expenses from funds appropriated to the State Board of
21 Education for that purpose. The members of the Task Force shall
22 be reimbursed for their travel expenses from appropriations to
23 the State Board of Education available for that purpose and

1 subject to the rules of the appropriate travel control board.

2 (b) The State Board of Education shall provide
3 administrative and other support to the Task Force.

4 (c) The Task Force shall conduct a study on the heroin use
5 problem in high schools and suggest programs for high schools
6 to use to address the problem, which programs may involve local
7 law enforcement agencies.

8 (d) On or before June 30, 2014, the Task Force shall report
9 its findings and recommendations to the General Assembly, by
10 filing copies of its report as provided in Section 3.1 of the
11 General Assembly Organization Act, and to the Governor.

12 (e) The Task Force is abolished and this Section is
13 repealed on July 1, 2014.

14 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
15 becoming law.
