SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

815 ILCS 505/2QQQ new

Amends the Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business Practices Act. Provides that it is an unlawful practice for a person to impose a surcharge upon a consumer who elects to pay by use of a credit card instead of making payment by cash, check, or similar means of payment. Effective immediately.

- Sec. 2000. Credit card surcharges prohibited.
- 8 (a) No person in any sales transaction may impose a
- 9 surcharge upon a consumer who elects to pay by use of a credit
- card instead of making payment by cash, check, or similar means
- of payment.
- 12 (b) A violation of this Section constitutes an unlawful
- practice within the meaning of this Act.
- 14 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 15 becoming law.
