1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 1022 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend House Bill 1022 by replacing 3 everything after the enacting clause with the following: "Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the Task 4 5 Force on Sustainable Transportation Funding Act. 5. Task Force on Sustainable Transportation 6 Section 7 Funding. There is created the Task Force on Sustainable Transportation Funding, to be comprised of the following 8 9 members, with an emphasis on bipartisan and statewide 10 legislative representation and diverse non-legislative stakeholder representation: 11 12 (1) one member of the Illinois House of Representatives 13 members of and the public who represent 14 transportation industry, the Illinois transportation

research community, or national research and policy-making

bodies appointed by the Speaker of the House of

Representatives;

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- (2) one member of the Illinois Senate and 2 members of the public who represent the transportation industry, the Illinois transportation research community, or national research and policy-making bodies appointed by the President of the Senate;
- (3) one member of the Illinois House of Representatives and 2 members of the public who represent the transportation industry, the Illinois transportation research community, or national research and policy-making bodies appointed by the Minority Leader of the House of Representatives;
- (4) one member of the Illinois Senate and 2 members of the public who represent the transportation industry, the Illinois transportation research community, or national research and policy-making bodies appointed by the Minority Leader of the Senate;
- (5) one member who is currently employed by the Illinois Department of Transportation appointed by the Secretary of the Illinois Department of Transportation; and
- (6) one member who is currently employed by the Illinois Department of Revenue appointed by the Director of the Illinois Department of Revenue.
- Section 10. Membership; voting rights.

- 1 (a) The Task Force shall serve without compensation.
- (b) The members of the Task Force shall be considered 2
- 3 members with voting rights. A quorum of the Task Force shall
- 4 consist of a simple majority of the members of the Task Force.
- 5 All actions and recommendations of the Task Force must be
- approved by a simple majority vote of the members. 6
- 7 (c) The Task Force shall meet within 60 days after the
- effective date of this Act. The Task Force shall elect one 8
- 9 member as chairperson at its initial meeting through a simple
- 10 majority vote of the Task Force and shall thereafter meet at
- 11 the call of the chairperson.
- Illinois Department of Transportation shall 12 (d) The
- 13 provide administrative and other support to the Task Force.
- 14 Section 15. Duties; report.
 - (a) The Task Force shall:

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- 16 (1)analyze the current trends between
- 17 infrastructure needs of Illinois and the revenue received
- 18 from federal and State gas taxes and the level of highway
- 19 and road investment that would reduce congestion, keep
- 20 Illinois' economy competitive, and keep drivers safe;
- 21 (2) research and recommend possible alterations and
- alternatives for how to modernize the State of Illinois' 22
- 23 system of financing maintenance, improvements,
- 24 expansion of its public infrastructure systems, including,
- 25 but not limited to, best practices in other states,

- user-based alternatives, or other equitable 1 and 2 sustainable methods for funding transportation;
- 3 (3) make recommendations to the Department of 4 Transportation regarding how to implement possible 5 alterations or alternatives; and
- (4) submit a report of its findings and recommendations 6 7 to the General Assembly by June 1, 2015.
- 8 Section 30. Repealer. This Act is repealed on January 1, 9 2016.
- 10 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 11 becoming law.".
