1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 1155

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 1155, AS AMENDED, by  
3 inserting the following in its proper numeric sequence:

4 "Section 270. The Firearm Owners Identification Card Act is  
5 amended by changing Section 5 as follows:

6 (430 ILCS 65/5) (from Ch. 38, par. 83-5)

7 Sec. 5. The Department of State Police shall either approve  
8 or deny all applications within 30 days from the date they are  
9 received, and every applicant found qualified pursuant to  
10 Section 8 of this Act by the Department shall be entitled to a  
11 Firearm Owner's Identification Card upon the payment of a \$20  
12 ~~\$10~~ fee. Any applicant who is an active duty member of the  
13 Armed Forces of the United States, a member of the Illinois  
14 National Guard, or a member of the Reserve Forces of the United  
15 States is exempt from the application fee. \$8 ~~\$6~~ of each fee  
16 derived from the issuance of Firearm Owner's Identification

1 Cards, or renewals thereof, shall be deposited in the Wildlife  
2 and Fish Fund in the State Treasury; \$9 ~~\$1~~ of such fee shall be  
3 deposited in the State Police Services Fund and \$3 of such fee  
4 shall be deposited in the Firearm Owner's Notification Fund.  
5 Monies in the Firearm Owner's Notification Fund shall be used  
6 exclusively to pay for the cost of sending notices of  
7 expiration of Firearm Owner's Identification Cards under  
8 Section 13.2 of this Act. Excess monies in the Firearm Owner's  
9 Notification Fund shall be used to ensure the prompt and  
10 efficient processing of applications received under Section 4  
11 of this Act.
