AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 1155

inserting the following in its proper numeric sequence:

4 "Section 75. Firearm liability insurance.

- (a) Any person with a handgun carry license under this Act shall maintain a policy of liability insurance in the amount of at least \$1,000,000 specifically covering any damages resulting from negligent or willful acts involving the use of the firearm while it is owned by that person. A person shall be deemed the owner of a firearm after the firearm is lost or stolen until the loss or theft is reported to the police department or sheriff of the jurisdiction in which the owner resides.
- (b) If the Department of State Police finds that the person to whom the license was issued possesses or acquires a firearm and does not submit evidence to the Department that he or she has been issued in his or her name a liability insurance policy
