1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 1156

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 1156, AS AMENDED, by  
3 inserting the following in its proper numeric sequence:

4 "Section 40. Locking devices and safe storage for  
5 prohibited weapons. At any time when a person exempted from  
6 the prohibition on possessing weapons under this Act is not in  
7 immediate possession of a prohibited weapon owned or controlled  
8 by that person, he or she must keep a locking device or  
9 mechanism on the prohibited weapon that renders the prohibited  
10 weapon temporarily inoperable, including but not limited to a  
11 device that attaches to the prohibited weapon with a key or  
12 combination lock, and is designed to prevent the prohibited  
13 weapon from being discharged unless the device has been  
14 deactivated. If the prohibited weapon is incapable of accepting  
15 a locking device, the person must keep the prohibited weapon  
16 unloaded and placed within a securely locked box or container  
17 that requires a key or combination lock to open.".
