On the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly, the The corporate authorities of a municipality <u>shall</u> <u>may</u> establish a finance and an audit committee, and shall may appoint members of the corporate authority, or other appropriate officers, and members of the public to the committee, to review audit reports prepared under this Act and any other financial reports and documents, including management letters prepared by or on behalf of the municipality.

13 The duties of the finance and audit committee shall 14 include, but are not limited to:

- (1)inspecting, on a semi-annual basis, the treasurer's books and accounts;
- (2) reviewing, on a <u>semi-annual basis</u>, all financial accounts and financial activities of the municipality with any bank, savings and loan association, savings bank, credit union, or any other financial institution;
- (3) reviewing, on <u>an annual basis</u>, a list of all municipal accounts with any bank, savings and loan association, savings bank, credit union or any other financial institution;
 - (4) reviewing, on a semi-annual basis, any management
