1 AN ACT concerning civil law.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Eminent Domain Act is amended by changing
5 Section 20-5-25 as follows:

6 (735 ILCS 30/20-5-25) (was 735 ILCS 5/7-107)

7 Sec. 20-5-25. Persons contesting not to be prejudiced.
8 Neither the plaintiff nor ~~nor~~ any party interested in the
9 property, by taking any action authorized by Sections 20-5-5
10 through 20-5-20, inclusive, of this Act, or authorized under
11 Article 25 of this Act, shall be prejudiced in any way in
12 contesting, in later stages of the proceeding, the amount to be
13 finally ascertained to be just compensation.
