1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 1815

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 1815 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding  
5 Section 3-699 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/3-699 new)

7 Sec. 3-699. Diabetes Awareness license plates.

8 (a) The Secretary, upon receipt of an application made in  
9 the form prescribed by the Secretary, may issue special  
10 registration plates designated as Diabetes Awareness license  
11 plates. The special plates issued under this Section shall be  
12 affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division and  
13 motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than  
14 8,000 pounds. Plates issued under this Section shall expire  
15 according to the multi-year procedure established by Section  
16 3-414.1 of this Code.

1       (b) The design and color of the plates is wholly within the  
2 discretion of the Secretary of State. The Secretary, in his or  
3 her discretion, may allow the plates to be issued as vanity or  
4 personalized plates under Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The  
5 Secretary shall prescribe stickers or decals as provided under  
6 Section 3-412 of this Code.

7       (c) An applicant for the special plate shall be charged a  
8 \$40 fee for original issuance in addition to the appropriate  
9 registration fee. Of this fee, \$25 shall be deposited into the  
10 Diabetes Research Checkoff Fund and \$15 shall be deposited into  
11 the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund, to be used  
12 by the Secretary to help defray the administrative processing  
13 costs.

14       For each registration renewal period, a \$27 fee, in  
15 addition to the appropriate registration fee, shall be charged.  
16 Of this fee, \$25 shall be deposited into the Diabetes Research  
17 Checkoff Fund and \$2 shall be deposited into the Secretary of  
18 State Special License Plate Fund."
