1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 2530

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 2530 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Counties Code is amended by adding Section
5 5-1183 as follows:

6 (55 ILCS 5/5-1183 new)

7 Sec. 5-1183. Donation bins.

8 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a donation
9 bin in any county shall have a permanent, written, printed
10 label affixed to the bin and prominently displayed. The label
11 shall include the name, address, and telephone number of the
12 person or entity owning, operating, or maintaining that bin.
13 Any entity that does not meet the criteria for a "not for
14 profit" designation shall label its bin as "for profit". Any
15 entity that does meet the criteria for "not for profit" shall
16 label its bin as "not for profit".

1 (b) As used in this Section:

2 "Donation bin" or "bin" means a container or receptacle
3 held out to the public as a place for people to donate
4 clothes, shoes, and books and to store them until taken
5 away for donation or resale by the entity that owns,
6 operates, or maintains the bin.

7 "Not for profit" means any entity that is officially
8 recognized by the United States Internal Revenue Service as
9 a tax-exempt entity described in Section 501(c)(3) of the
10 Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or any successor provision
11 of federal tax law).

12 Section 10. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by
13 adding Section 11-42-15 as follows:

14 (65 ILCS 5/11-42-15 new)

15 Sec. 11-42-15. Donation bins.

16 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a donation
17 bin in any municipality shall have a permanent, written,
18 printed label affixed to the bin and prominently displayed. The
19 label shall include the name, address, and telephone number of
20 the person or entity owning, operating, or maintaining that
21 bin. Any entity that does not meet the criteria for a "not for
22 profit" designation shall label its bin as "for profit". Any
23 entity that does meet the criteria for "not for profit" shall
24 label its bin as "not for profit".

1 (b) As used in this Section:

2 "Donation bin" or "bin" means a container or receptacle
3 held out to the public as a place for people to donate
4 clothes, shoes, and books and to store them until taken
5 away for donation or resale by the entity that owns,
6 operates, or maintains the bin.

7 "Not for profit" means any entity that is officially
8 recognized by the United States Internal Revenue Service as
9 a tax-exempt entity described in Section 501(c)(3) of the
10 Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or any successor provision
11 of federal tax law).

12 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
13 becoming law."
