1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 2530

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 2530 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Counties Code is amended by adding Section
5 5-1183 as follows:

6 (55 ILCS 5/5-1183 new)

7 Sec. 5-1183. Donation bins.

8 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a donation
9 bin in any county shall have a permanent, written, printed
10 label affixed to the bin and prominently displayed. The label
11 shall include the name, address, and telephone number of the
12 person or entity owning, operating, or maintaining that bin.
13 Any entity that does not meet the criteria for a "not for
14 profit" designation shall label its bin as "for profit".

15 (b) As used in this Section:

16 "Donation bin" or "bin" means a container or receptacle

1 held out to the public as a place for people to drop off
2 personal property and to store it until taken away.

3 "Not for profit" means any entity that is officially
4 recognized by the United States Internal Revenue Service as
5 a tax-exempt entity described in Section 501(c)(3) of the
6 Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or any successor provision
7 of federal tax law).

8 Section 10. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by
9 adding Section 11-42-15 as follows:

10 (65 ILCS 5/11-42-15 new)

11 Sec. 11-42-15. Donation bins.

12 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a donation
13 bin in any municipality shall have a permanent, written,
14 printed label affixed to the bin and prominently displayed. The
15 label shall include the name, address, and telephone number of
16 the person or entity owning, operating, or maintaining that
17 bin. Any entity that does not meet the criteria for a "not for
18 profit" designation shall label its bin as "for profit".

19 (b) As used in this Section:

20 "Donation bin" or "bin" means a container or receptacle
21 held out to the public as a place for people to drop off
22 personal property and to store it until taken away.

23 "Not for profit" means any entity that is officially
24 recognized by the United States Internal Revenue Service as

1 a tax-exempt entity described in Section 501(c)(3) of the
2 Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or any successor provision
3 of federal tax law).

4 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
5 becoming law."
