2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
Section 3-808.1 as follows:

Sec. 3-808.1. (a) Permanent vehicle registration plates
shall be issued, at no charge, to the following:

9 1. Vehicles, other than medical transport vehicles, 10 owned and operated by the State of Illinois or by any State 11 agency financed by funds appropriated by the General 12 Assembly;

2. Special disability plates issued to vehicles owned
and operated by the State of Illinois or by any State
agency financed by funds appropriated by the General
Assembly.

(b) Permanent vehicle registration plates shall be issued,for a one time fee of \$8.00, to the following:

Vehicles, other than medical transport vehicles,
 operated by or for any county, township or municipal
 corporation.

 23 corporations for persons with disabilities.

3. Beginning with the 1991 registration year,
 county-owned vehicles operated by or for any county sheriff
 and designated deputy sheriffs. These registration plates
 shall contain the specific county code and unit number.

5 4. All-terrain vehicles owned by counties, townships, or municipal corporations and used for law enforcement 6 7 purposes when the Manufacturer's Statement of Origin is 8 accompanied with a letter from the original manufacturer or 9 a manufacturer's franchised dealer stating that this 10 all-terrain vehicle has been converted to a street worthy 11 vehicle that meets the equipment requirements set forth in 12 Chapter 12 of this Code.

5. Beginning with the 2001 registration year, municipally-owned vehicles operated by or for any police department. These registration plates shall contain the designation "municipal police" and shall be numbered and distributed as prescribed by the Secretary of State.

6. Beginning with the 2014 registration year, 18 19 municipally owned, fire district owned, or Mutual Aid Box Alarm System (MABAS) owned vehicles operated by or for any 20 fire department, fire protection district, or MABAS. These 21 22 registration plates shall display the designation "Fire 23 Department" and shall display the specific fire 24 department, fire district, fire unit, or MABAS division 25 number or letter.

county-owned vehicles operated by or for any county sheriff and 1 2 designated deputy sheriffs that have been issued registration 3 plates under subsection (b) of this Section shall be exempt 4 from any fee for the transfer of registration from one vehicle 5 to another vehicle. Each county sheriff shall report to the 6 Secretary of State any transfer of registration plates from one 7 vehicle to another vehicle operated by or for any county 8 sheriff and designated deputy sheriffs. The Secretary of State 9 shall adopt rules to implement this subsection (c).

10 (c-5) Beginning with the 2014 registration year, 11 municipally owned, fire district owned, or Mutual Aid Box Alarm 12 System (MABAS) owned vehicles operated by or for any fire 13 department, fire protection district, or MABAS that have been 14 issued registration plates under subsection (b) of this Section shall be exempt from any fee for the transfer of registration 15 from one vehicle to another vehicle. Each fire department, fire 16 17 protection district, of MABAS shall report to the Secretary of State any transfer of registration plates from one vehicle to 18 19 another vehicle operated by or for any fire department, fire 20 protection district, or MABAS. The Secretary of State shall adopt rules to implement this subsection. 21

vehicle. Each municipal police department shall report to the Secretary of State any transfer of registration plates from one vehicle to another vehicle operated by or for any municipal police department. The Secretary of State shall adopt rules to implement this subsection (d).
