SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Amends the Chicago Teacher Article of the Illinois Pension Code. Makes changes concerning the composition and election of members of the Board of Trustees of the Fund. Effective immediately.

AN ACT concerning public employee benefits.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Pension Code is amended by changing
Sections 17-137, 17-138, 17-139, and 17-144 as follows:

6 (40 ILCS 5/17-137) (from Ch. 108 1/2, par. 17-137)

7 Sec. 17-137. Board created. There shall be elected a Board 8 of Trustees, herein also referred to as the "Board", to 9 administer and control the Fund created by this Article. The Board shall consist of 12 members, 2 of whom shall be members 10 of the Board of Education, 6 of whom shall be contributors who 11 are not administrators principals, one of whom shall be a 12 13 contributor who is an administrator a principal, and 3 of whom 14 shall be pensioners, all to be chosen as provided in this Article. 15

Sec. 17-138. Board membership. At the first meeting of the Board of Education in November of each year, the Board of Education shall appoint one of its members to serve, while a member of the Board of Education, on the Board of Trustees for a term of 2 years. HB3088

During the first week of November, On the last school day 1 2 of the 4th week of October of each year there shall be elected members of the Board from the teachers other than 3 2 administrators principals, who shall hold office for terms of 3 4 5 years, provided the trustee retains his or her while retaining their status as a teacher teachers other than an administrator 6 7 principals, and other members to fill any unexpired terms. In 8 the event that schools are not in session on or during the week prior to the last Friday in October, this election shall be 9 10 held on the Friday of the first subsequent full week of school. 11 The election shall be by secret ballot conducted in person or 12 by secure electronic ballot, and shall be held in such manner as the Board by bylaws or rules shall provide. Only teachers 13 14 who are not administrators principals shall be eligible to vote 15 in the election.

16 During the first week of November of 1995 and every third year thereafter, one contributor who is an administrator a 17 principal shall be elected a member of the Board. This trustee 18 shall hold office for a term of 3 years, provided the trustee 19 20 retains while retaining his or her status as an administrator a 21 principal. The election shall be by mail ballot or by secure 22 electronic ballot, and only contributors who are 23 administrators principals shall be eligible to vote. The election shall be held in the manner provided by the Board by 24 25 rule or bylaw.

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During the first week of November of each odd-numbered year

there shall be elected 3 members of the Board from the pensioners, who shall hold office for a term of 2 years while retaining their status as pensioners. The election shall be by mail ballot <u>or secure electronic ballot</u> to all service and disability pensioners, and shall be held in such manner as the Board by bylaws or rules shall provide.

7 All trustees, while members of the Board of Education or 8 while administrators principals, teachers other than 9 administrators principals, or pensioners, as the case may be, 10 shall hold their offices until their successors shall have been 11 appointed or elected and qualified by subscribing to the 12 constitutional oath of office at the immediately succeeding regular meeting of the Board. 13

16 Sec. 17-139. Board elections and vacancies.

(1) Contributors other than <u>administrators</u> principals 17 18 election. Every member who is not a principal or an 19 administrator may vote at the election for as many persons as there are trustees to be elected by the contributors who are 20 21 principals or administrators, provided that the not 22 contributor obtained that voter eligibility status on or before 23 September 1 of the election year. The name of a candidate shall 24 not be placed on printed upon the ballot unless he or she has 25 been assigned on a regular certificate for at least 10 years in

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the Chicago public schools or charter schools and nominated by a petition signed by not less than 200 contributors who are not principals or administrators.

Petitions shall be filed with the recording secretary of 4 5 the Fund on or after September 15 of each year and not later than October 1st of that year. No more than one candidate may 6 7 be nominated by any one petition. If the nominations do not exceed the number of candidates to be elected, the canvassing 8 9 board shall declare the nominated candidates elected. 10 Otherwise, candidates receiving the highest number of votes cast for their respective terms shall be declared elected. The 11 12 location and number of polling places shall be designated by the Board. The election shall be conducted by the teachers who 13 14 are not principals or administrators, and the judges of the election shall be selected from the teachers who are not 15 16 principals or administrators, in such manner as the board in 17 its bylaws or rules provides.

18 Elections to fill vacancies on the Board shall be held at 19 the next annual election.

20 (2) Pensioners election. The name of a candidate shall not 21 be <u>placed printed</u> on the ballot unless he or she has been 22 nominated by a petition signed by not less than 100 pensioners 23 of the Fund. Petitions shall be filed with the recording 24 secretary of the Fund on or before October 1 of the 25 odd-numbered year. If the nominations do not exceed 3, the 26 mailing of ballots shall be eliminated and the nominated

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1 candidates shall be declared elected. Otherwise, the 3
2 candidates receiving the highest number of votes cast shall be
3 declared elected. The mailing and counting of the ballots shall
4 be conducted by the office of the Fund with volunteer
5 assistance from pensioners at the request of the Board.

6 (3) Administrators Principals election. The name of a 7 candidate shall not be placed printed on the ballot unless he or she has been nominated by a petition signed by at least 25 8 9 contributors who are principals or administrators. Petitions 10 shall be filed with the recording secretary of the Fund on or 11 before October 1 of the election year. Every member who is a 12 principal or an administrator may vote at the election for one 13 candidate who is a contributor who is an administrator, 14 provided that the member obtained such voter eligibility status on or before September <u>1 of the election year</u> a principal. If 15 16 only one eligible candidate is nominated, the election shall 17 not be held and the nominated candidate shall be declared elected. Otherwise, the candidate receiving the highest number 18 of votes cast shall be declared elected. The mailing and 19 20 counting of the ballots shall be conducted by the office of the Fund. 21

(4) Vacancies. The Board may fill vacancies occurring in the membership of the Board elected by the principals, administrators, teachers other than principals or administrators, or pensioners at any regular meeting of the Board. The Board of Education may fill vacancies occurring in
