

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
5 Section 11-605 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/11-605) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 11-605)

7 Sec. 11-605. Special speed limit while passing schools.

8 (a) For the purpose of this Section, "school" means the
9 following entities:

10 (1) A public or private primary or secondary school.

11 (2) A primary or secondary school operated by a
12 religious institution.

13 (3) A public, private, or religious nursery school.

14 ~~When~~ ~~On a school day when school~~ children are present and
15 ~~within 50 feet of so close thereto that a potential hazard~~
16 ~~exists because of the close proximity of the~~ motorized traffic,
17 no person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed in excess of
18 20 miles per hour while passing a school zone or while
19 traveling on a roadway on public school property or upon any
20 public thoroughfare where children pass going to and from
21 school.

22 ~~For the purpose of this Section a school day shall begin at~~
23 ~~seven ante meridian and shall conclude at four post meridian.~~

1 This Section shall not be applicable unless appropriate
2 signs are posted upon streets and highways under their
3 respective jurisdiction and maintained by the Department,
4 township, county, park district, city, village or incorporated
5 town wherein the school zone is located. With regard to the
6 special speed limit while passing schools, such signs shall
7 give proper due warning that a school zone is being approached
8 and shall indicate the school zone and the maximum speed limit
9 in effect ~~during school days~~ when ~~school~~ children are present.

10 (a-5) The Department, township, county, park district,
11 city, village, or incorporated town wherein the school zone is
12 located shall, by July 1, 2015, erect signs that give proper
13 warning that a school zone is being approached and indicate the
14 maximum speed limit in effect when children are present.

15 (b) (Blank).

16 (c) Nothing in this Chapter shall prohibit the use of
17 electronic speed-detecting devices within 500 feet of signs
18 within a special school speed zone indicating such zone, as
19 defined in this Section, nor shall evidence obtained thereby be
20 inadmissible in any prosecution for speeding provided the use
21 of such device shall apply only to the enforcement of the speed
22 limit in such special school speed zone.

23 (d) (Blank).

24 (e) A first violation of this Section is a petty offense
25 with a minimum fine of \$150. A second or subsequent violation
26 of this Section is a petty offense with a minimum fine of \$300.

1 (f) When a fine for a violation of subsection (a) is \$150
2 or greater, the person who violates subsection (a) shall be
3 charged an additional \$50 to be paid to the unit school
4 district where the violation occurred for school safety
5 purposes. If the violation occurred in a dual school district,
6 \$25 of the surcharge shall be paid to the elementary school
7 district for school safety purposes and \$25 of the surcharge
8 shall be paid to the high school district for school safety
9 purposes. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
10 entire \$50 surcharge shall be paid to the appropriate school
11 district or districts.

12 For purposes of this subsection (f), "school safety
13 purposes" includes the costs associated with school zone safety
14 education, the Safe Routes to School Program under Section
15 2705-317 of the Department of Transportation Law of the Civil
16 Administrative Code of Illinois, safety programs within the
17 School Safety and Educational Improvement Block Grant Program
18 under Section 2-3.51.5 of the School Code, and the purchase,
19 installation, and maintenance of caution lights which are
20 mounted on school speed zone signs.
