SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations to the Office of the Attorney General for its FY14 ordinary and contingent expenses. Effective July 1, 2013.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The amount of \$30,843,200, or so much thereof
5 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
6 Fund to the Office of the Attorney General to meet its
7 operational expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30,
8 2014.

9 Section 10. In addition to other amounts appropriated,
10 the amount of \$1,400,000, or so much thereof as may be
11 necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
12 the Office of the Attorney General for operational expenses,
13 awards, grants, and permanent improvements for the fiscal
14 year ending June 30, 2014.

15 Section 15. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as
16 is available for use by the Attorney General, is appropriated
17 to the Attorney General from the Illinois Gaming Law
18 Enforcement Fund for State law enforcement purposes.

19 Section 20. The sum of \$1,700,000, or so much thereof as
20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Asbestos Abatement

1 Fund to the Attorney General to meet the ordinary and
2 contingent expenses of the Environmental Enforcement-Asbestos
3 Litigation Division.

4 Section 25. The amount of \$8,750,000, or so much thereof
5 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney
6 General Court Ordered and Voluntary Compliance Payment
7 Projects Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for use,
8 subject to pertinent court order or agreement, in the
9 performance of any function pertaining to the exercise of the
10 duties of the Attorney General, including State law
11 enforcement and public education.

12 Section 30. The amount of \$1,900,000, or so much thereof
13 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois
14 Charity Bureau Fund to the Office of the Attorney General to
15 enforce the provisions of the Solicitation for Charity Act
16 and to gather and disseminate information about charitable
17 trustees and organizations to the public.

18 Section 35. The amount of \$7,700,000, or so much thereof
19 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney
20 General Whistleblower Reward and Protection Fund to the
21 Office of the Attorney General for ordinary and contingent
22 expenses, including State law enforcement purposes.

1 Section 40. The amount of \$9,350,000, or so much thereof
 2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney
 3 General's State Projects and Court Ordered Distribution Fund
 4 to the Attorney General for payment of interagency
 5 agreements, for court-ordered distributions to third parties,
 6 and, subject to pertinent court order, for performance of any
 7 function pertaining to the exercise of the duties of the
 8 Attorney General, including State law enforcement and public
 9 education.

10 Section 45. The following named amounts, or so much
 11 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
 12 and purposes named in this Section, are appropriated to the
 13 Attorney General to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses
 14 of the Attorney General:

6 Section 50. The amount of \$240,000, or so much thereof
7 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Child Support
8 Administrative Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for
9 child support enforcement purposes.

10 Section 55. The amount of \$3,000,000, or so much thereof
11 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney
12 General Federal Grant Fund to the Office of the Attorney
13 General for funding for federal grants.

14 Section 60. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
15 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the
16 Attorney General from the Domestic Violence Fund pursuant to
17 Public Act 95-711 for grants to public or private nonprofit
18 agencies for the purposes of facilitating or providing free
19 domestic violence legal advocacy, assistance, or services to
20 victims of domestic violence who are married or formerly
21 married or parties or former parties to a civil union related
22 to order of protection proceedings, or other proceedings for

1 civil remedies for domestic violence.

2 Section 65. The amount of \$3,500,000, or so much thereof
3 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney
4 General Tobacco Fund to the Office of the Attorney General
5 for the oversight, enforcement, and implementation of the
6 Master Settlement Agreement entered in the case of People of
7 the State of Illinois v. Philip Morris, et al (Circuit Court
8 of Cook County, No. 96L13146), for the administration and
9 enforcement of the Tobacco Product Manufacturers' Escrow Act,
10 for the handling of tobacco-related litigation, and for other
11 law enforcement activities of the Attorney General.

12 Section 70. The amount of \$50,000, or so much thereof as
13 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney General
14 Sex Offender Awareness, Training, and Education Fund to the
15 Office of the Attorney General to administer the I-SORT
16 program and to alert and educate the public, victims, and
17 witnesses of their rights under various victim notification
18 laws and for training law enforcement agencies, State's
19 Attorneys, and medical providers regarding their legal duties
20 concerning the prosecution and investigation of sex offenses.

21 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
22 2013.
