Makes appropriations to the Illinois Power Agency for specified purposes. Effective July 1, 2013.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The amount of \$2,626,522, or so much thereof
5 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Power
6 Agency from the Illinois Power Agency Operations Fund for its
7 ordinary and contingent expenses.

8 Section 10. The amount of \$914,900, or so much thereof as
9 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Power
10 Agency from the Illinois Power Agency Trust Fund for deposit
11 into the Illinois Power Agency Operations Fund pursuant to
12 subsection (c) of Section 6z-75 of the State Finance Act.

13 Section 15. The amount of \$51,000,000, or so much thereof
14 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Power
15 Agency from the Illinois Power Agency Renewable Energy
16 Resources Fund for funding of purchases of renewable energy
17 or renewable energy credits pursuant to subsections (b) and
18 (c) of Section 1-56 of the Illinois Power Agency Act.

19 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
20 2013.
