1 AN ACT concerning elections.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the Tax
- 5 for Education Referendum Act.
- 6 Section 5. Referendum. The State Board of Elections shall
- 7 cause a statewide advisory question of public policy to be
- 8 submitted to the voters at the general election to be held on
- 9 November 4, 2014. The question shall appear in the following
- 10 form:
- "Should the Illinois Constitution be amended to require
- that each school district receive additional revenue,
- 13 based on their number of students, from an additional 3%
- tax on income greater than one million dollars?"
- The votes on the question shall be recorded as "Yes" or
- 16 "No".
- 17 Section 10. Certification. The State Board of Elections
- shall immediately certify the question set forth in Section 5
- of this Act to be submitted to the voters of the entire State
- to each election authority in Illinois.

- Section 15. Conflicts. If any provision of this Act 1
- conflicts with any other law, this Act controls. 2
- Section 20. Repeal. This Act is repealed on January 1, 3
- 4 2015.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 5
- 6 becoming law.
