If and only if Senate Bill 2202 of the 98th 4 5 General Assembly, as amended by House Amendment No. 1, becomes 6 law, then "An Act concerning higher education" (Senate Bill 7 2202 of the 98th General Assembly) is amended by changing Section 15 as follows: 8 (S.B. 2202 98th G.A., Sec. 15) 9 10 Sec. 15. Prohibitions on smoking. (a) Beginning on July 1, 2015, smoking is prohibited on 11 12 each campus of a State-supported institution of higher education. The prohibition set forth in this subsection (a) 13 shall not apply to any instance in which an individual is 14 15 traveling through or parked on a campus in a vehicle that is not owned by a State-supported institution of higher education. 16

1 (b) An individual or campus subject to the smoking 2 prohibitions of this Act may not discriminate or retaliate in 3 any manner against a person for making a complaint of a 4 violation of this Act or furnishing information concerning a 5 violation to a person, campus, or governing authority.

6 (c) The prohibitions on smoking in this Act must be 7 communicated to all students and employees of State-supported 8 institutions of higher education on or before May 1, 2015 and 9 to each guest of a State-supported institution of higher 10 education upon request.

(d) Each State-supported institution of higher education shall create and post on its Internet website a smoke-free campus map indicating the locations where smoking is prohibited under this Act.
