AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 4056

AMENDMENT NO. $\qquad$ . Amend House Bill 4056 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following:

```
"Section 5. The Animal Welfare Act is amended by adding Section 3.05 as follows:
```

(225 ILCS 605/3.05 new)
Sec. 3.05. Restrictions on the sale of dogs and cats. No pet shop operator or dog dealer shall purchase a dog or cat for resale or sell or offer for sale any dog or cat purchased from:
(1) any breeder that:
(A) is not in possession of a current Class A or Class B animal dealer license issued by the United States Department of Agriculture and any applicable State agency;
(B) was found to have committed a direct violation of pet dealer-related regulations of the United States

Department of Agriculture during the 2-year period prior to the purchase;
(C) received "no access" violations on the 2 most recent inspection reports issued by the United States Department of Agriculture; or
(D) was found to have committed 3 or more indirect violations of pet dealer-related regulations of the United States Department of Agriculture during the 2-year period prior to the purchase, provided the violations pertained to the health or welfare of an animal and were not administrative in nature; or (2) any other person, firm, or corporation that:
(A) is not in possession of a current Class A or Class B animal dealer license issued by the United States Department of Agriculture and any applicable State agency;
(B) was found to have committed a direct violation of pet dealer-related regulations of the United States Department of Agriculture during the 2-year period prior to the purchase;
(C) received "no access" violations on the 2 most recent inspection reports issued by the United States Department of Agriculture;
(D) was found to have committed 3 or more indirect violations of pet dealer-related regulations of the United States Department of Agriculture during the

2-year period prior to the purchase, provided the violations pertained to the health or welfare of an animal and were not administrative in nature; or
(E) directly or indirectly, has obtained the dog or cat from a breeder described in subdivision (1) of this subsection.".
