SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

15 ILCS 305/12

from Ch. 124, par. 10.2

Amends the Secretary of State Act. Provides that the Secretary of State shall impose a fee of \$20 per month payable by all State employees (currently payable by all persons) parking in certain parking facilities in Springfield. Permits the Secretary of State to set a fee by rule in the event that a non-State employee requests a space located in either garage. Provides that the funds so collected shall be deposited in the State Parking Facility Maintenance Fund (rather than 80% in the Capital Development Bond Retirement and Interest Fund and 20% in the State Parking Facility Maintenance Fund). Effective immediately.

FISCAL NOTE ACT MAY APPLY

1 AN ACT concerning State government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Secretary of State Act is amended by changing Section 12 as follows:
- 6 (15 ILCS 305/12) (from Ch. 124, par. 10.2)
- 7 Sec. 12. Parking fees; leases.
- (a) The Secretary of State shall impose a fee of \$20 per 8 9 month payable by all State employees persons parking vehicles in the underground parking facility located south of the 10 William G. Stratton State Office Building in Springfield and 11 the parking ramp located at 401 South College Street located 12 west of the William G. Stratton State Office Building in 13 14 Springfield, unless a non-State employee requests a space located in either garage, in which case the Secretary shall set 15 16 the fee by rule. State officers and employees who make 17 application for and are allotted parking places in such parking facilities shall authorize the Comptroller to deduct the 18 19 required fees from their payroll checks under the State Salary and Annuity Withholding Act and the amounts so withheld shall 20 21 be deposited as provided in Section 8 of that Act. Persons who 22 are not subject to the State Salary and Annuity Withholding Act and who are allotted parking places under this Section shall 23

- 1 pay the required fees directly to the Office of the Secretary
- of State and the amounts so collected shall be deposited as
- 3 follows: 80% in the Capital Development Bond Retirement and
- 4 Interest Fund in the State Treasury and 20% in the State
- 5 Parking Facility Maintenance Fund in the State Treasury.
- 6 (b) The Secretary of State may enter into agreements with
- 7 public or private entities or individuals to lease to those
- 8 entities or individuals parking spaces at State-owned
- 9 Secretary of State facilities. Such agreements may be executed
- 10 only upon a determination by the Secretary that leasing the
- 11 parking spaces will not adversely impact the delivery of
- services to the public. The fee to be charged to the entity or
- individual leasing the parking spaces shall be established by
- 14 rule. All funds collected by the Secretary pursuant to such
- 15 leases shall be deposited in the State Parking Facility
- 16 Maintenance Fund and shall be used for the maintenance and
- 17 repair of parking lots at State-owned Secretary of State
- 18 facilities.

- 20 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 21 becoming law.
