Amends the Illinois Pseudorabies Control Act. Provides that members of the Pseudorabies Advisory Committee shall only serve for the duration of the pseudorabies outbreak within the State. Provides that the committee shall only meet during the duration of the pseudorabies outbreak. Effective immediately.

AN ACT concerning animals.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Pseudorabies Control Act is amended
by changing Section 5.1 as follows:

6 (510 ILCS 90/5.1) (from Ch. 8, par. 805.1)

7 5.1. Pseudorabies Advisory Committee. Upon the Sec. detection of pseudorabies within the State, the The Director of 8 9 Agriculture is authorized to establish within the Department an 10 advisory committee to be known as the Pseudorabies Advisory Committee. Such committee shall consist of, but not be limited 11 to, representatives of swine producers, general 12 swine 13 organizations within the State, licensed veterinarians, 14 general farm organizations, auction markets, the packing industry and the University of Illinois. Members of this 15 16 committee shall only serve for the duration of the pseudorabies 17 outbreak. The committee shall only meet during the duration of the pseudorabies outbreak. The Director shall, from time to 18 19 time, consult with the Pseudorabies Advisory Committee on 20 changes in the pseudorabies control program.

The Director shall appoint a Technical Committee from the membership of the Pseudorabies Advisory Committee, which shall be comprised of a veterinarian, a swine extension specialist, HB5398 - 2 - LRB098 17274 MGM 52368 b

and a pork producer. This committee shall serve as resource persons for the technical aspects of the herd plans and may advise the Department on procedures to be followed, timetables for accomplishing the elimination of infection, assist in obtaining cooperation from swine herd owners, and recommend adjustments in the approved herd plan as necessary.

7 These Committee members shall be entitled to reimbursement 8 of all necessary and actual expenses incurred in the 9 performance of their duties.
