720 ILCS 5/24-1.3 new

Amends the Criminal Code of 2012. Provides that it is unlawful for any person to possess a suppressor for any firearm that has had its serial number removed or altered. Provides that a violation is a Class 3 felony. Effective immediately.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Criminal Code of 2012 is amended by adding
Section 24-1.3 as follows:

6 (720 ILCS 5/24-1.3 new)

Sec. 24-1.3. Possession of a suppressor without a serial
number or with an altered serial number.

9 <u>(a) It is unlawful for any person to possess a suppressor</u> 10 <u>for any firearm that has had its serial number removed or</u> 11 <u>altered.</u>

12 (b) Sentence. A violation of this Section is a Class 3
13 <u>felony.</u>

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
