1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 5816 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend House Bill 5816 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following: 3 "Section 5. The Illinois Pension Code is amended by adding 4 Section 1-136 as follows: 5 6 (40 ILCS 5/1-136 new)7 Sec. 1-136. Public corruption and other disqualifying 8 felony convictions. (a) If a person is convicted of, or pleads guilty to, a 9 Class X felony or a Class 1 felony, then none of the benefits 10 11 that are provided under this Code and that are attributable to the service of that person shall be paid. 12 (b) If a person is receiving an annuity or pension from a 13 pension fund or retirement system established under this Code 14 15 and is convicted of, or pleads guilty to, a felony, other than a felony requiring the forfeiture of that annuity or pension 16

under subsection (a) of this Section or any other provision of this Code, then the board of trustees of that fund or system shall suspend the payment of the annuity or pension for the duration of that person's incarceration for that offense. Upon completion of the term of incarceration for that offense, the person may seek reinstatement of his or her annuity or pension by filing a request for reinstatement of benefits with the applicable pension fund or retirement system in the manner prescribed by that fund or system.

- (c) A person who forfeits his or her benefits under this Section is entitled to a refund of his or her unused employee contributions to the extent that the refund of those contributions is necessary in order for the pension fund or retirement system to maintain qualified plan status under the federal Internal Revenue Code of 1986.
- (d) A board of trustees of a pension fund or retirement system established under this Code may take action in addition to the provisions of subsections (a) and (b) of this Section regarding a person subject this Section. A board of trustees of a pension fund or retirement system established under this Code may not take action that is less stringent than the provisions of this Section.
- (e) This Section applies without regard to whether the member or participant is in active service on or after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly.".
