Amends the Clerks of Courts Act. Provides that with regard to any notification required by law to be made by the circuit clerk to a party, the circuit clerk may reasonably rely upon any notice of the party's change of address received from the United States Postal Service as a true and correct statement of the party's current residential address.

3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Clerks of Courts Act is amended by adding
5 Section 12.5 as follows:

6 (705 ILCS 105/12.5 new)

7 Sec. 12.5. Party change of address. With regard to any
8 notification required by law to be made by the circuit clerk to
9 a party, the circuit clerk may reasonably rely upon any notice
10 of the party's change of address received from the United
11 States Postal Service as a true and correct statement of the
12 party's current residential address.
